

Theses and Dissertations

The Doucette Library houses most of the Master's theses and Doctoral dissertations written by students in the Faculty of Education since the late 1960s. They are located in the far back corner of the library and recognizable by their consistent blue binding. All theses have a call number of 370 EDC, followed by the year of writing.

They are organized in chronological order on the shelf, and then by author's last name within each year. Some older theses are stored in the Doucette's historical collection. Ask for these at the circulation desk; they will be retrieved for you and can be borrowed.

To search for theses and dissertations in the Doucette Library, use the Advanced Search screen, and from the 'location' menu select *Doucette Library – Thesis collection* (see below)
