

Videos and DVDs

The Doucette Library has almost 1,500 videorecordings – either on videocassette or DVD. Some are about ‘how to teach’ and these often show classroom situations; more relate to curriculum topics and are meant for showing to K-12 students.

Videos and DVDs are integrated on the shelves along with the books of the same call number.

Searching

There are two different ways to search specifically for video materials:

1. use the word ‘videorecording’ along with your subject search
e.g. mathematics videorecording
2. use the **Advanced Search** screen and from the ‘specialized format’ menu choose either DVD or VHS-Video. (see below)
Limit your search to the Doucette if you choose.
